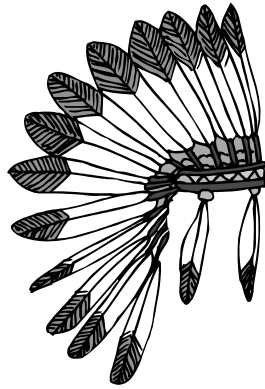

Ages 7 & 8 Grades 2 & 3

Banquet Patch- Big and Little Brave/Princess will plan, purchase, cook and serve dinner. Mother is not allowed in the kitchen. After serving dinner, Big and Little Brave/Princess will do the dishes.

Black and White Feather-Conduct Tribal Meeting

Hiking Patch- Complete a 1-mile walking hike with Big Brave. This can be a tribe outing. A report should be made at a tribe meeting, interesting things observed.

Graduation Patch-Earn all 17 Coup Patches

4th Year

Ages 8-9 Grades 3& 4

Astronomy Patch-Child must be able to identify the Big Dipper, Orion's Belt, and 3 other constellations or planets.

Flag Patch- Child must give a brief history of the American Flag including the significance of the stars and stripes and their numbers. Also, they must tell how to properly handle, fold, and show respect of the flag in front of their tribe.

Recycling Patch-Dad and child must collect and recycle 50 pounds of trash.

Compass Patch-Kids must demonstrate a basic knowledge of a compass and its use. They should be able to identify all parts and show how to use a map and compass to follow an indicated route.

Archery Patch-Child should be able to talk about bow safety and the parts of the bow and arrow. They should be able to demonstrate proper shooting form and be able to hit the target with 5 out of 10 arrows. This can coup can be demonstrated at either the Spring or Fall Pow Wow.

Photography Patch-Child must learn how to use a camera correctly. The should take pictures of objects that spell out their initials, have them developed, and show them to the tribe.
